Subject: Request to speak out against ethnically targeted police raids in Greece

Dear **[MEP Name]**,

I am writing to you as a constituent to raise urgent concerns about Operation ENTOS, a coordinated police campaign by the Greek state targeting Romani communities.

Since September 2025, Greek authorities have conducted [at least 93 militarised raids on Roma-majority neighbourhoods](#). 473 officers have been deployed across 152 communities. These raids involve drones, K-9 units, riot police, and dawn door-breaks, tactics normally associated with border enforcement, now being used against EU citizens inside their own homes.

The Greek government frames this as a crackdown on organised crime, but the data shows that arrests are overwhelmingly for minor offences such as lack of ID or illegal electricity connections in areas of deep racialised poverty. Greek police press releases never use the word "Roma," instead referring to "socially homogeneous groups," language that appears designed to bypass anti-discrimination protections while ethnically targeting specific neighbourhoods.

This is part of the same securitisation of racialised minorities going on across Europe, enabled by the far-right and regressive legislation such as the Migration Pact. The silence from Brussels is deeply troubling. If Greece faces no consequences, I am concerned that this model will spread.

I am asking you to use your platform to speak out publicly against these ethnically targeted police raids in Greece. As an MEP, your voice can bring attention to this issue and pressure the Commission and Greek authorities to act.

I would be grateful for a response outlining your position and any action you are able to take.
